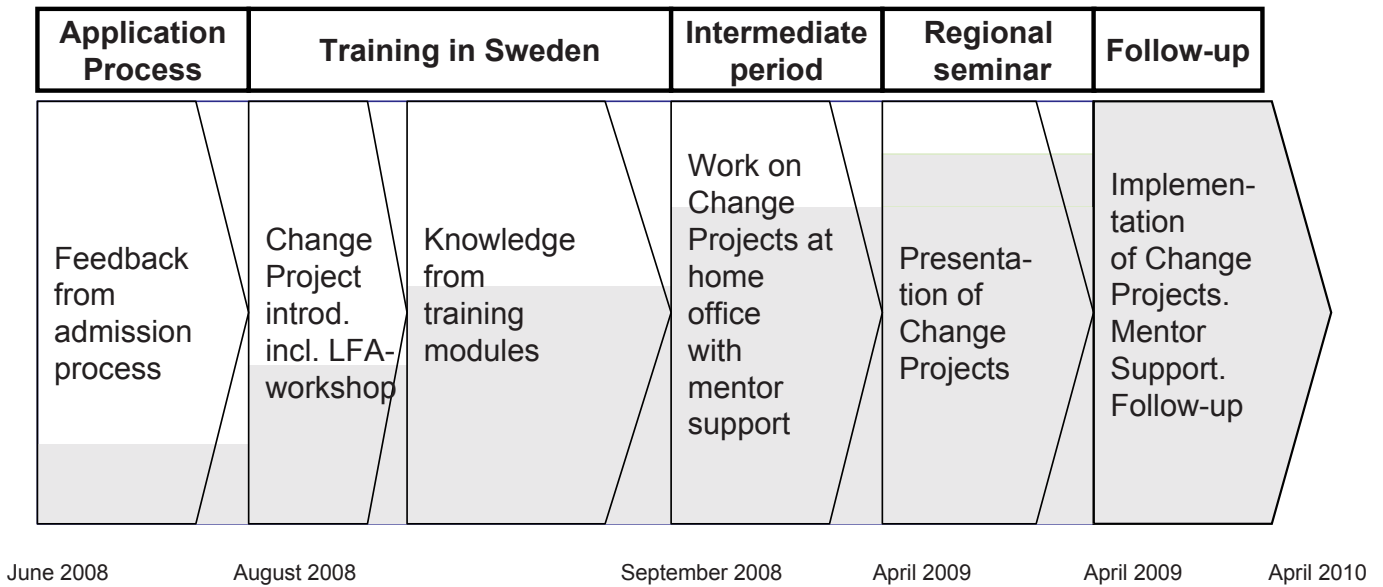

A condition for the selection as participant in the EDM programme is a well described Change Project. The project shall accomplish a sustainable improvement of the conditions in the country or organisation of the Applicant.

### Examples of possible Change Projects:

- Implementation of pilot rural electrification project.
- Implementation of loss reduction in pilot area/s.
- Improvement of customer service and customer satisfaction.
- Development and implementation of policies for local renewable energy solutions.
- Improvement of environmental conditions in pilot area/s by electrification.
- Establishment of local energy advisors.
- Implementation of energy efficiency programme in pilot areas.
- Implementation of procedures for improved cooperation between institutions, organisations, utilities, etc.
- Creation of model for prioritisation of electrification projects.
- Creation of models for management of isolated electrified areas.
- Development of financing models for rural electrification.

When **evaluation** the proposed change projects the following issues will be considered:

#### General relevance and realism

- Is the project within a relevant area for this programme?
- Has the project a technical relevance?
- Has the project a realistic size, not too small and not too big?

#### Conditions for implementation

- Has the applicant a position in his/her organisation to make it realistic to implement the project?
- Has the applicant sufficient support from his organisation?

#### Economy

- Has the project a realistic economy?
- Can the project be financed?

#### Sustainability

- Can the project become sustainable?

- Is the project robust in choice of technical solutions and organisation?

#### Performance improvement

- Will the project contribute to extended, more reliable and more stable electricity supply?

#### Relation to relevant processes in the country

#### Poverty reduction and improved gender equality

- Will the most poor in the country benefit from the project?
- Will the project contribute to increased equality between groups in the society and between women and men?
